Directions to Geneva Point Center:

Located in the Lakes Region of New Hampshire, Geneva Point is accessible by air or land transportation.

By car from the South, take I-93 North to Exit 23 and turn right onto Route 104 for 9 miles. At the junction of Route 104 and U.S. Route 3, make a left turn onto Route 3 for approximately 1 mile. At the traffic lights in Meredith, bear right onto Route 25 (and stay on 25) through the town of Center Harbor for a total of 8 miles. At the traffic lights (just beyond the Motel and Service Station), turn right onto Moultonboro Neck Road and travel for 5.7 miles. Bear left at fork in the road onto Winaukee Road. At the next corner turn left onto Geneva Point Road and drive to the Geneva Point Center entrance sign. **Look for NEMF signs.**

By car from the North, take I-93 South to Exit 23 or Route 16 to Route 25 South, then pick up the above directions at either of these two points.

By car from the West, take Route 104 East, the pick up the above directions where the route crosses I-93.

By car from the East, go to Route 25 from Route 16, then turn left onto Moultonboro Neck Road.

By air: Manchester Airport, Manchester NH.
